The verbal phrase (the Conqueror's excellent children praise) is made into a noun. It becomes a verbal adjective modifying the noun "path" (the path praised by Conqueror's excellent children).

If "path" had it occurred before "praise" in the sentence (as it does in the example; "The Conqueror's excellent children praise the path"; "path" would have been the **object of the verb "Praise."** Therefore, the 6th case is called a "clause connective to the object."



The list of 3 noun phrases is collectively the object of the verb explain: "I will explain 1, 2 and 3."
