



The verbal phrase (the Conqueror's excellent children *praise*) is made into a noun. It becomes a verbal adjective modifying the noun **"path"** (the path *praised* by Conqueror's excellent children).

If "path" had it occured before "praise" in the sentence (as it does in the example; "The Conqueror's excellent children praise the path", "path" would have been the object of the verb "Praise." Therefore, the 6th case is called a "clause connective to the "object."
